HOW TO ENCOURAGE YOUR Child THROUGH STRENGTHS

Want to keep seeing a behavior? Encourage your child to continue to grow the strength that goes with that behavior. Instead of giving empty praise with phrases, "Good job!", encourage the process and action. Over time, your child will be intrinsically motivated, more likely to repeat the positive behavior and develop resiliency and confidence to accomplish great things.

Simple Phrases that ENCOURAGE & MOTIVATE

- "You showed your _{character trait or strength]_ when you ______."
- "You've shown __{strength}__ by __{action}__."
- "Your __{effort}__ helped you __{results of that positive behavior}__."
